Message from the Principal

Dear Parents,

I hope that all our families continue to cooperate with our staff who have dedicated their lives to serve our children. It was good to see the 43 families who took the opportunity provided by Grade 2 and 3 teachers to familiarise parents with how to help their children with their studies. We hope that another session can be held in the near future for those who missed out.

God bless you all with a peaceful and safe weekend.


